

Hello there,

Here is a run-down of a Manuscript Contract with Dragon Soul Press.

Royalties:

Publisher – 70%

Author – 30%

Payments:

Made quarterly after publication.

The fiscal year shall be broken up into four quarters with dates as follows:

Quarter 1	January 1 to March 31
Quarter 2	April 1 to June 30
Quarter 3	July 1 to September 30
Quarter 4	October 1 to December 31

The Publisher agrees to render quarterly statements of account in duplicate and to make payments on or before 31 days after the end of each quarter.

Formats:

E-book, paperback, and hardcover.

Word Limit:

Paperbacks- 10,000-word minimum

Hardcovers- 20,000-word minimum

Distribution Countries:

US, UK, DE, FR, ES, IT, NL, JP, BR, CA, MX, AU, IN.

Copyright:

Publisher keeps the full rights until either party decides otherwise. For example, if the Author decides to publish elsewhere. A time period of three months from the date of notification will be allowed for the manuscript to be unpublished and removed from the Publisher entirely. If the money has not been made back from the book, the Author does not get the final edited and formatted copy. The book cover graphics are also forfeit.

Process:

The submissions team reviews it. If accepted, a contract is sent to the author. Once signed, the editing and formatting process begins. A cover will be designed by the Graphics Department. The manuscript is published for e-book, paperback, and hardcover. Then heavily marketed and distributed to several countries.

Marketing:

Advertisements are created across all social media. A cover reveal event and a book release event. Virtual written author interviews.
